SMALLTOWN, USA

Welcome to Austin, Indiana. Population 4500. A small rural town with the largest HIV outbreak in Indiana history. Over 135 cases have been diagnosed since March 2015. A public health emergency has been declared in this county by the Governor. Needle sharing is to blame for the breakout. Sharing of used needles to shoot IV drugs like Opana, a synthetic liquefied pain killer seems to be the drug of choice currently in this small community. An emergency needle exchange was set up to help prevent the spread of HIV. New syringes, information on drug rehabilitation, bandages, cotton balls and condoms are given out to help prevent the spread of HIV. Many health officials fear this is just the start of the epidemic.

Indiana has Specialists from other states assisting in identifying contacts of the newly diagnosed cases to help prevent the spread of HIV. The HIV virus is transmitted three ways: blood to blood, sexually, and mother to baby. Call your local health department to find out about testing.
